Bills for water/sewer service shall be rendered monthly and shall be delinquent 15 days after their rendition. Any bill not paid by the fifteenth of the month will be delinquent, immediately assessed a 10% penalty and accrue a 10% penalty for every 30 days thereafter that it remains unpaid. Any customer that has a delinquent bill that is 60 days old or totals \$150.00, whichever occurs first, will be hand delivered a disconnect notice. The customer will have 10 days to pay the outstanding balance. If the balance is not paid, then water service will be terminated. In accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code, Sec. 11-126-4, a delinquent bill becomes a lien upon the property as of the delinquency date. Service shall not be provided to any property against which the Village of Thomasboro has filed a lien which remains unsatisfied.

For violation of any of the foregoing rules or for the nonpayment of water/sewer bills, the Village of Thomasboro reserves the right to turn off the water without further notice. After the water has been turned off from any service pipe on account of nonpayment of water/sewer bills or violation of rules, the same will not be turned on until all delinquent bills and penalties are paid, together with the expense of turning off and on such meter. A reconnect fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) will be charged for turning off/on water service. Any person who is indebted to the Village of Thomasboro for water consumed, materials or repairs associated with water service, shall not be provided with water service at any location until such debts are satisfied. Customer will provide access for water department personnel to read the water meter and to perform required maintenance.

RENTER / TENANT

A deposit of \$150.00 is required for water service, paid in advance, and will be refunded upon termination of the water/sewer service, provided that all current and past due bills have been paid in full. Deposit Amount \$ \_\_\_\_\_ Date Paid \_\_\_\_\_
