VILLAGE BOARD MEETINGS

REPORTING STREET LIGHT PROBLEMS

Have you noticed a street light in your area not working properly or in need of repairs? Please call Ameren Illinois at 1-800-755-5000 to report any issues with street lights. The toll free Answer Center is available to Ameren customers 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Ameren personnel will complete normal street light repairs such as bulb or eye replacement within 2 working days.

NEW STOP SIGN PLACEMENT

With the passage of Ordinance No. 608, amending Chapter VII of the Thomasboro Municipal Code, this authorizes the placement of a stop sign at the intersection of Church Street and the northern access road to the grain elevator.

SECOND WATER METERS

With colder weather approaching, residents with second water meters are reminded to bring those meters inside during the winter months to prevent freeze damage. The second meters are your property and you are responsible for their maintenance – so please take care of them.


Community Trunk or Treat!

REPUBLIC-EXTRA GARBAGE

There is starting to be extra trash put outside the garbage totes. Starting with our July statement, the following extra charges have gone in to effect: \$4.00 per extra can, \$5.00 per extra bag, \$44.00 per yd of extra trash. If you have a second Republic garbage tote, that price stays the same at \$6 per month. Republic will notify the village office of the extra trash amount, address, and date of the extra trash. The resident will receive a letter with the amount and date of extra trash that will be added to their water bill.

If you know that you need more than one garbage tote, please call the village office at 643-2675 and Republic will deliver the extra tote. The monthly charge for the second tote is \$6.00 and that will save you the extra weekly charges.

Also, if there is a holiday that lands on Monday or Tuesday of the week, the garbage pick-up day will be a day later and picked up on Thursday of the holiday week.


- Wear light-colored clothing short enough to prevent tripping and add reflective items.

- Watch for vehicle traffic when walking on the street, as well as crossing the street.
- Only giver or accept wrapped or packaged candy.
- Examine all candy before allowing children to eat it.
- Children, do not accept rides from people you do not know.
