THOMASBORO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NEWS

The Thomasboro Fire Department continues to look for volunteers interested in serving their neighbors and community as firefighters. If you would like to be considered, please stop by the fire station on any Tuesday evening and pick up an application.

VILLAGE NOW ACCEPTING ONLINE PAYMENTS FOR WATER BILLS

In an effort to improve customer service, the Village of Thomasboro announces that residents will now be able to pay water and sewer bills using credit or debit card through the secure Illinois Funds E-Pay online site. Payments may be made using MasterCard, Discover, or American Express; however, Visa is not being accepted at this time.

To use the E-Pay system, customers will need to visit the Village's website (http://thomasboro.us) and click on the "E-Pay" link. Once on the site, customers will need to enter their 8-digit water account number found in the upper left corner of the water and sewer bill card (e.g. 100100.10). If you don't

have your bill available or need to verify the balance due, please contact the Water Department at 643-2675. Please note that credit or debit card payments can only be made using the E-Pay site; the Village is not able to accept cards in person at Village Hall.

Residents are also reminded that the Village offers the convenient Direct Debit option for water and sewer payments. If you participate in Direct Debit, the full amount of your monthly bill will be automatically deducted from your bank checking account on the 15th day of each month. SPRING COMMUNITY CLEANUP DAY – MAY 16

The Village Board has set our seasonal Community Cleanup for Saturday May 16th, from 8:00am to noon. The Village has been working very hard to clean up our community, and this is an opportunity for residents to help us in our goal of making Thomasboro more attractive for residents and visitors alike. Dumpsters will be located at the water plant at 606 W. Central Avenue. This program is open to all Thomasboro residents, and participants will be required to show a current driver's license with a Village of Thomasboro address. Once again, we will be asking participants for a freewill donation to help defray the costs of having the dumpsters and recycling semi-trailer on site. Village officials will be monitoring the dumpsters, as there are a few items which will not be permitted (including, but not necessarily limited to: hazardous chemicals, paint, automobiles, tires, tree limbs, yard waste, batteries, electronics, and raw garbage. No one is allowed to leave anything at the site before May 17th at 8:00am or after the dumpsters have been filled and covered. Trustees ask that you enter the parking lot from the Schluter Street side and exit onto Central.

SPRING TOWN SALES TO BE HELD JUNE 6

This year, Village leaders have decided to hold our community garage/yard sales in conjunction with the Street Dance weekend on Saturday, June 6th. The Village will advertise for the event; however, you may place advertisements for your own sales as well. Participating households are encouraged to mark their garage/yard sales with balloons or signs attached to your mailboxes or lamp posts to help draw attention to your sale.

THOMASBORO POLICE MONITORING SCHOOL ZONES

The Thomasboro Police Department will be monitoring school zones, and wants to remind drivers to be watchful of school students. Police will monitor for: violations of school speed zones, using a cellular device in a school zone, passing stopped school buses, and disobeying school crossing guards.

Chief Keith Willis recommends that motorists give themselves a little bit of extra time on the roads and pay close attention while driving – with the approaching warmer weather there will be an increased number of children walking or riding bicycles to school.

NEW SPEED LIMITS!!

The Thomasboro Police Department reminds all drivers that the posted speed limit on village streets and roadways is now 25mph, with the exception of Central Avenue which is now 30mph.

VACATION SECURITY CHECKS

The Thomasboro Police Department offers vacation security checks to all Thomasboro residents. While you are away on vacation, officers from the police department will periodically stop by your home to check for open doors, broken windows or any other suspicious circumstances. This is another added security precaution you can utilize to safeguard your possessions and assure your peace of mind while you enjoy your time away. This is a free, but invaluable service provided by the Thomasboro Police Department to our citizens. Please stop by Village Hall and complete a vacation security request form to take advantage of this service.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

YOUR VILLAGE YOUR COMMUNITY KEEP IT SAFE & CLEAN

Code compliance deals with a range of neighborhood issues from inoperable motor vehicles parked in yards and driveways, to health and sanitation – which include garbage, trash and public appearance. Other issues related to the code enforcement officer are weeds and foliage control.

Should the code enforcement officer see a violation on a resident's property, a letter will be sent to the resident outlining the issue and a copy of the ordinance will be included, along with information on what the resident needs to do to come into compliance.

The goal of code enforcement is maintaining the quality of life in your neighborhood. Residents can do their part by observing community standards and neighbor-friendly items.

There will be judging in two categories: Ribs and Chicken. Each entry will be \$15.00 (total of \$30.00 to enter in both categories). Trophies will be given to the First and Second place entries in both categories, with cash purse and trophy being awarded to the overall champion.

Check-in time will be from 7:00am to 8:00am on June 6, with meat check at 8:00am. All meat must be packaged prior to the start of the competition. Turn-in times for judging will be 1:00pm for chicken and 2:00pm for ribs. Awards will be announced at approximately 3:30pm. Preregistration is encouraged.
